

Our Learning Newsletter: Autumn 2

 English 	 Maths 
In school we are looking at: Magazines Home learning opportunities: Can they have a look at the different magazine covers in the shops? Are they able to list 3 of their interests? Can they take some photos of their favourite things? Can they create a title for a magazine of their choice?	In school we are learning: Money Skills Home learning opportunities: Create a tuck shop at home and exchange money for items – label them different prices and provide a small allowance. Draw around different coins and write in the value of each coin. Go to a shop or café and help them to work out how many coins they need to pay.
 PSHE 	 Computing 
In school we are learning: Money & Finances Home learning opportunities: This is very similar to our maths topic and can work really well together. Let them play with different coins, help them identify the different ones. Create savings jar – allow them to do little jobs around the home and pop a coin in every time they complete a job. Count up their money jar – see how much they have earned. What can they spend it on? Discuss the difference between a want (toy) and a need (clothes, food)	In school we are learning: Different types of technology Home learning opportunities: Can they point to different technology around the home? Can they use different types of technology? Can they explain what the different types of technology are used for? Can they help to use the remote/toaster/washing machine? What technology is important to them?
 Life Skills 	 PE 
In school we are learning: Autumn Festivals Customs, Dressing [up] Skills. Laces, buttons & zips Home learning opportunities: Provide your child with as much independence as possible. Allow them to try and thread their shoe laces, let them have a go at doing their zips on their coats. Can you get them to do some buttons up on cardigans? How about getting them to join in with you when you put your coat on, can they do it up for you?	In school we are learning: Target Games Home learning opportunities: Ball games, throwing and catching. Jumping, walking, hopping and balancing as appropriate for your child's needs. Play throw and catch with them. If you have use ramps & guttering to allow them to push a ball towards a target like a homemade version of bocchia.
