 <p>English</p> 	 <p>Maths</p> 
<p>In school we are learning: About Julia Donaldson's 'Sharing a Shell', we will be writing a book report about what we think of the story.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Does your child enjoy reading or listening to stories? Can they show you in their own way what they think of the story? For example, smiling or laughing, verbally, or using symbols.</p>	<p>In school we are learning: About problem solving skills, working out problems linked to size, sorting, and number.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Can you and your child do some sorting games? Or posting different size objects through different holes - is one too big for the hole? Is there a bigger hole it could go in?</p>
 <p>PSHE</p> 	 <p>Computing</p> 
<p>In school we are learning: About keeping safe and people who help to keep us safe, like parents, teachers and firefighters. We also will be thinking about how to ask for help.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Who can you see out and about that may be able to help? Can you find police or fire stations? Can your child ask for help in their own way?</p>	<p>In school we are learning: About data collection and using technology to present data.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Can you play games where you need to record the results? For example, rolling a dice, how many times does it land on each number? Or can you play time trials with your child? For example, how many balls can you throw into a container in a minute?</p>
 <p>Life Skills</p> 	 <p>PE</p> 
<p>In school we are learning: About using tools when cooking – we will be chopping, whisking, kneading dough, and lots more!</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Can you use tools with playdough at home? Kneading, cutting, manipulating? Can you involve your child in any process of cooking?</p>	<p>In school we are learning: About team building and orienteering. We will be working together towards a goal and following trails to a destination.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: Can you play games that require teamwork? For example, working together to keep a balloon from touching the floor.</p>
