## **Summer School 2021**

The Cedar School received £8060 from the Covid-19 Summer School grant which allowed us to invite 10 pupils (of which 8 attended) to a sports-based summer school over the holidays.

The summer school itself ran for a total of 10 days across two weeks.

The grant also allowed us to provide staff members to support the individual needs of the children.

The club was managed by experienced sports coaches and provided opportunities for our pupils to participate in a variety of team games, physical games and social activities. This included giving the pupils opportunities to mix with children from mainstream schools and enhance their social skills.

The impact of the camp was that the children were empowered to take part in sports and activities which they would not normally participate in as well as improving resilience and communication skills.

The camp also impacted the wellbeing of our young people as it gave them an opportunity within the holidays to spend time with friends outside of the school environment. Feedback from our children is that they were excited, happy and thankful for the opportunity!
