

This half term, we will be learning all about poetry in English. We have chosen The Puffin Book of Fantastic First Poems to read each week as we explore different poems together. In maths, the students will continue working towards their individual targets and goals. In computing, we are beginning to learn about internet safety, including understanding what personal information is. We are also starting to explore sound and music this half term in both our science and DT lessons. In humanities, we will be learning about Medieval Southampton. In PE, we are beginning our athletics unit and in life skills we will be focusing on the skills needed for getting dressed, including using laces, buttons, and zips.

Pick one of the three activities below to try out at home!

Try reading a poem together, either from a book at home or from one you find online. You could talk about what each of the words mean, why they may have picked specific words or what the author is trying to say. You may also have a go at writing your own poem!

Practice your independence in dressing skills. Whether you are heading out or getting ready for bed, see how independent your child can be with getting dressed. Socks are often a difficult one, as well as zips so any practice with this would be great!

You can start listening to different kinds of music with your child. It would be good to note how it makes you feel, they could draw a picture about it or even make some marks and see if this changes based on the song or type of music. Make a song or your own music if you can!
