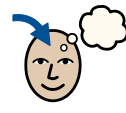




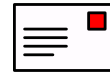

This half term, Green Class will be exploring a play in English. We have chosen *Fantastic Mr Fox* as our focus text. In Maths, all pupils will continue working towards their individual targets, which may include areas such as number recognition, counting, addition and subtraction, sorting and other key mathematical skills tailored to each child's needs. In Computing, we will be learning how to record data and what to do with it once we have collected it. Our Science theme focuses on states of matter, where we will learn about the different states and perform experiments. In Humanities, we will explore Victorian times in England and what it was like to live during that period. For PE this half term, a specialist group will be coming in to teach our children how to play cricket. As the weather starts to brighten up, we will also be learning gardening skills during our life skills lessons. We are all really excited for this half term and can't wait to get started!
