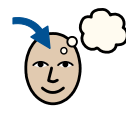




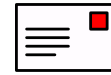

Green class will look at "The Man on the Moon!" as our text this half term.

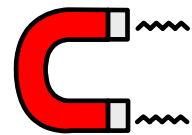
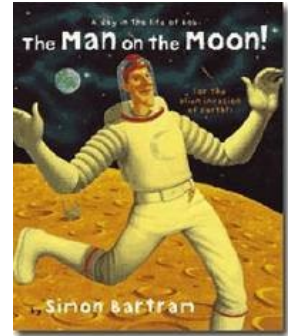
In Maths, all pupils will continue to work towards their own targets, including number recognition, counting, addition and subtraction, sorting, and other related skills.

In Computing, we are working on coding and looking at stories online.

Our Science theme focuses on Forces and Magnets, and in Humanities we will explore Southampton at War and Modern Southampton.

For PE this half term, we will be playing specialist net and wall games such as tennis, badminton, or volleyball.

As always, we will be focusing on healthy eating as well as healthy movement in our Life Skills lessons.



Pick one of the three activities below to try out at home!

If you head into town at any point, keep an eye out for anything old or new. Do the buildings look old or new? What do you think they looked like during the war? Are the buses new or old? Try to spot anything different between now and the past.

For an independent task, we are focusing on helping out around the home. Children could make an astronaut's snack (using raisins, fruit, crackers, jam for example) and then, when finished, they could tidy up afterwards themselves.

If you can access our class book at home, try turning off the lights and using a torch as "moonlight," wrapping blankets around as "space suits," and reading the story together.
