





Can they teach you/ another family member?</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Budgeting- looking at managing small budgets (such as pocket money) and also gaining an overview of managing bigger household budgets.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Give your child opportunities to budget. For example, give them a small shopping list and a fixed amount of money they can spend to get the items on the list.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Encourage your child to get involved in some of the household budgeting chores, such as looking at the water bills. How much are they a year/month? Is it cheaper to pay by direct debit?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Net and wall games</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Can your child make their own net games, such as aiming to throw their washing in the washing bin? Or throwing balls/ beanbags into a bucket?</p>

In our discovery days, we will be focussing on humanities, science, RE and creative subjects.

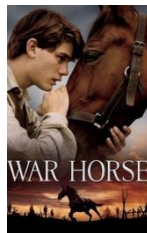
(Naomi will be back teaching in Ruby Class on Fridays for the Summer term!)
