The role of a school governor is a very rewarding one which would enable you to meet new people and to work as part of a team. You would gain new knowledge and skills and would be able to bring a valuable perspective to the work of the board.

Don't worry if you have no experience, as full training and support is available and you will be well supported by your colleagues on the governing body.

The governing body's main tasks are:

- to ensure that the school has a clear vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- to hold the Headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils;
- to oversee the financial performance of the school, making sure its money is well spent.

Parent governors are valued members of the team and play a vital role in ensuring that the governing body has access to parent/carer perspectives and a greater knowledge of the local community.



Here at Cedar we are mindful of how challenging it can be to attend in-person meetings. Therefore most of our meetings are held on zoom, always at 5pm on a Tuesday and not usually lasting longer than an hour and a half. Standardly a governor attends two or three meetings a term. Governors also visit school for monitoring activities once a term.
