Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our RE curriculum the whole school will be visiting St John's Church, Rownhams on **Thursday 2nd December 2021.** This will also form part of our Christmas activities over the next few weeks.

We will not have a service, but there will be a short story, some carols and a chance to explore the church and its grounds. Pupils will be split into two groups for activities inside and outside the church in order to limit too much close contact, as we are still aware of the ongoing impact of Covid-19. Additionally, we will be asking that **all pupils and adults** have a lateral flow test on the day of the trip. This includes primary-aged pupils. Please indicate on the slip below if you are happy for your child to have a lateral flow test. This can be done by staff in school or yourself the night before.

We will be walking up to the church, which, as some families will know, is somewhat of a Cedar tradition! As such, pupils who sometimes use electric wheelchairs will need to use their manual wheelchairs on this day for safety when crossing roads etc. If this will be an issue for your child, please contact the school office ASAP.

This will be a morning event and so will not impact on pick-up as it has in previous years. Pupils will be leaving school at 9.40 and returning by 11.45 for lunch.

This event will not be open to parents and families, however if any parent or carer wishes to volunteer to help on the walk and/or at the church will be much appreciated.

Please note that you will not necessarily be volunteering to help with your child's class but in any class across the school. As above, you will also need to complete a lateral flow test before attending.
