We are truly sorry for this but know that you appreciate that we must always respond to advice about everyone's safety.

Thank you to you all, and to your amazing children, for remaining so upbeat throughout this half-term despite the Covid challenges which we have faced.

After half-term, as nationwide Covid restrictions lift, we are going to make some further changes in school:

- We will end our class Bubbles arrangements, enabling all children to mix together
- This means that we can start to use some of our specialist rooms for all children again
- Some lunch time clubs will begin; there will be clubs every day

We plan to extend opportunities even further over the next few weeks ... so, assuming that nationwide and local Covid figure do not rise, we are optimistic of something that resembles 'normal Cedar' being able to re-emerge!
