## Notification of Industrial Action during February and March 2023

The wording of this letter is largely taken from a template sent to schools by Southampton City Council to ensure that families across the city are receiving consistent information.

Further to my email last week and as you will be aware from the recent media coverage, National Education Union (NEU) members have voted to take industrial action in our area on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2023, 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2023, 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023 and 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

The action (a series of one day strikes) is not against the school itself but is part of industrial action organised by the union.

There is no requirement for unions to inform us of which members of staff will take action, as there is no obligation on members of unions to obey a strike call. If we have a high number of staff taking action it could possibly lead to either partial or full closure of the school.

This letter is being sent to give you advanced notice that the governors and I will need to consider in due course the action we will have to take. Given that union members are not required to confirm that they will be taking part in industrial action, the notification to you may be very late.

We will continue to update you with news via email or by letter. **Please do keep an eye on all messages from school over the coming days.** Potentially information regarding the first strike date could be issued as late as the evening of 31<sup>st</sup> January or even early on 1<sup>st</sup> February.
