











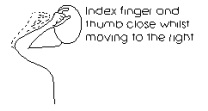
Our Learning Newsletter: Summer 2

Throughout this half term we are going to be developing our skills in each of the below learning areas though the topic Music and Me; My Playlist and Festivals.

 <h3>My Communication</h3> 	 <h3>My Cognition</h3> 
<p>In school we are learning: To continue to make and show clear and confident choices through looking between and reaching for preferred objects. We will be doing this through exploring a range of musical genres alongside supporting props to develop a personalised and individual playlist.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: To listen to and respond to a range of music genres!</p>	<p>In school we are learning: To develop our attention and tracking skills through sorting sensory shapes and number parachute activities. We are also going to be repeating actions to create desired effects and collecting data around musical choices from others in class and around the school.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: To encourage your child to look towards and track objects around them within their daily home routine.</p>
 <h3>My Body</h3> 	 <h3>My Community</h3> 
<p>In school we are learning: To enhance our gross motor skills through reaching and striking a range of different sized balls towards a series of targets both close and further away from us.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: To explore gross motor movements through reaching, grasping and target games!</p>	<p>In school we are learning: To explore, communicate and respond to others around the whole school. To do this we are going to be hosting a whole school talent show!</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: To have opportunities to be involved in conversations with new people such as shop workers etc.</p>
 <h3>My Care and Independence</h3> 	 <h3>PSHE</h3> 
<p>In school we are learning: To participate and engage with activities which can affect the local community such as litter picking and gardening. We will also be focusing on making our own choices at social times and taking ourselves to where we would like to spend time.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: To go on a litter pick in the local community or supporting with the gardening.</p>	<p>In school we are learning: To respond with curiosity to prompting about babies and identify some differences between a baby, child and adult. To do this we will be exploring and comparing photos of us when we were younger to us today with supporting stimuli.</p> <p>Home learning opportunities: To talk about and observe different activities in the local community which people of different ages might participate in.</p>
