













Our Learning Newsletter: Summer 1

| <p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: How to write a newspaper reports and write their own memories poem</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: Can they explore magazines, reports and newspaper articles. Research famous poets and poems. Read and discuss a selection of Shakespeare Sonnets. Explore writing a Haiku or acrostic poem about a favourite memories.</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: Fractions, decimals, percentages and position</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: When exploring food can they cut the food into fractions and discuss the fractions they create related percentages $\frac{1}{2}=50\%$, $\frac{3}{4}=75\%$ and $\frac{1}{4}=25\%$. This could also be done with money- what is half of £1, £2. Can they give instructions to someone else on moving an object clockwise, anti-clockwise or making a grid and use coordinates.</p> |

Is there anything else they need to help them keep a good routine (deodorant/ more time to have a shower etc.? Do they know which medical professionals they have involved with them and how to contact them if needed?)</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">In school we are learning: Creating pictures</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Home learning opportunities: By applying the computing skills they have learned, can your child create a piece of artwork that demonstrates the concept of 'layering'? Can they use shapes, lines, ordering and grouping objects as well as manipulation to turn a straightforward picture into a masterpiece!?</p> |
