Home learning opportunities:

Ask your children to help you with the washing. Can they identify the labels? Ask them to separate their washing and what setting it should be washed at. Ask them to help you put the washing out on the line/clothes horse or even use the tumble drier.

In school we are learning:

Striking skills relating to the games of football, basketball, hockey, boccia and tennis. Home learning opportunities:

To watch the London 2012 Olympic/ Paralympic games and find out about our athletes.

Find out about the athletes who will competing in the summer 2024 games. With household objects practise scoring and aiming for a target e.g. socks into a wash basket and paper into a bin.
