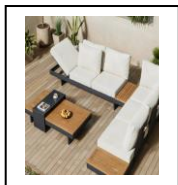


Our Learning Newsletter: Summer 2

Project!

Ruby Class will be working on a project developing an outdoor seating area for the older children of the school.



The children will be encouraged to work as independently as possible to do so. They will be in charge of all the different elements of making this happen, from deciding where this seating area should be, putting a proposal together for SLT to ask for the funding, ordering the items and putting it all together!

This will include maths (measuring up, working out costs etc.) English (writing proposals, lists etc.), computing (putting together surveys and navigating websites) and speaking and listening (asking other children what they would like from the seating area.). They will also be developing many skills needed for a future career and general independence and life skills.



We also hope to plan and attend a trip to a garden centre to buy some resources (and maybe even stop to have a cuppa and some cake!).
