Play 'human robots' giving directions (left/right/forwards) to get to a named place.</p> |

| <p>In school we are learning: about healthy breakfasts and shopping skills Home learning opportunities: When you are in the supermarket, look at all the different breakfast options and maybe encourage your child to try something different. Make some blueberry pancakes to try.</p> | <p>In school we are learning: Net and wall games Home learning opportunities: Watch adapted versions of net and wall games on youtube such as sitting volleyball or wheelchair tennis. You could also use a balloon and have your child strike the balloon. Keep count of how many they do in 2 minutes and then try and beat it.</p> |
